BIG IDEA: Praise God

Over and over in the Psalms, David praises God for his greatness! He focuses on His power and might and victory. He created all things and rules over all things. We can learn a lot about praising God by following David's example. Today's lesson will help us to spend time praising God for who He is!



STEP ONE: READ THE BIBLE STORY

Psalms 145 from the NIV
Pages 218-221 in the Read with Me Bible



STEP TWO: CHOOSE AN ACTIVITY

FOR YOUNGER KIDS: Praise God! He Is the Creator!

Materials: Modeling Compound

God created everything! That is a great reason to praise him! Gather around the table and have each family member use the modeling compound to form something from God's creation! Do as many sculptures as you like! Give each person a chance to share their creations! Then take time as a family to pray and thank God for making each one!

FOR YOUNGER KIDS: Praise Snowflakes

Materials: White paper, scissors, tape

Did you know that snowflakes can help us remember to praise God? Think about it...

- They fall from the sky, like little gifts of love.
- They are all different and unique—just like God made each of us.
- They are beautiful and so detailed.
- They cover the ground with a blanket of white, just as Jesus covers us with his forgiveness.

Now have some fun making paper snowflakes--summer snowflakes! If you are not sure how to make a snowflake, there are tons of tutorials on YouTube.

Once you have a good collection of snowflakes, choose a word that describes God to write on each snowflake: Good • Holy • Great • Mighty • Loving • Forgiving • etc.

Tape your Praise Snowflakes to your windows as reminders to praise God!
