NO SHORTCUTS

The Christian life is not a magic bullet; it's a process that involves tensions + triumph. God forms us through the process, not around it. Faith is often uneasy—beautiful and gritty at the same time.

The big question in the letter of James is this:

How do I live out my faith and stay faithful when life is hard and unfair?

JAMES 1:1 NLT

Who Is James?

- Half-brother of Jesus
- Former skeptic, convinced by the resurrection
- Writing to believers under pressure and persecution
- A pastor offering practical wisdom for real life

JAMES 1:2-8 NLT

1. Redefine Your Perspective (vv. 2–4)

- Trials are inevitable and come in many forms
- Joy is not denial, but choosing how we interpret our trials
- God uses testing to form perseverance and maturity
- God is not wasting your trial

2. Redirect Your Attention (vv. 5–8)

- Trials create confusion—wisdom is needed
- Biblical wisdom is not answers, but faithful direction.
- God gives wisdom generously when we ask
- Divided trust leads to instability

JESUS + A LONG OBEDIENCE IN THE SAME DIRECTION

James didn't come up with this on his own—he watched his half-brother, Lord and Savior live it out!

The Christian life is a long obedience in the same direction, which is uneasy—filled with tensions + triumph!
