Series Conclusion

Jonah's story is more than a fish tale—it's a mirror to our own. We all run from God, but He keeps pursuing with grace.

Truth #1: Following God is Disrupting

God's call took Jonah far from home and far from comfort. Obedience disrupts what's easy, predictable, and safe.

Reflection Question

Has following God disrupted your comfort lately?

Truth #2: Following God is Exposing

Jonah's joy in comfort and bitterness at grace revealed his heart. God often removes comforts to expose what's within.

Reflection Question

What's being revealed in your heart right now?

Truth #3: Following God is Disturbing

God's mercy offended Jonah—it violated his sense of fairness. But grace always violates fairness—or it wouldn't be grace.

Gospel Hope

Because God did not spare His own Son, He can spare us. Grace is possible for everyone—even those we think don't deserve it.

Are you keeping score, or receiving grace?
Let God rewrite your story.
