A PIVOT FROM THE PLAN

Watching the Wind → Following the Spirit's lead to John 14 instead of the parenting series.

Now what? How do we become the vision, not just know it?

Exclusive Devotion + Dependent Obedience have always been at the central of movements of God.

EXCLUSIVE

John 13:34-John 14:7 NIV

- Vision starts in the heart, not with hype.
- "Don't let your hearts be troubled... Believe in Me."
- Father's house = family expanding around one table (insula).
- Jesus prepared the way at the cross and opened it through the resurrection.

Way → Direction in a world of disorientation

Truth → Clarity in a world of confusion

Life → Wholeness in a world of brokenness

Jesus is inclusively exclusive—everyone's invited, but only through Him.

DEVOTION

John 14:8-11 NIV

True devotion = trust + attachment + obedience

Don't chase "one more then"

Be satisfied in Jesus alone—the cross and empty tomb are enough.

THE PROMISE

John 14:12-14 NIV

Greater works = greater scope through the Spirit

Is my heart ready to pursue becoming this vision?

Am I truly devoted to Jesus—or do other devotions pull me away?

Who or what might be sitting on the throne of my life alongside or above Jesus?
