- Rejoice (v. 1)
 - Worldly joy depends on favorable circumstances.
 - Christian joy depends on a connection to and delight in Christ.
- Watch out (v. 2)
 - Knowledge and understanding of God's word (Phi 1:9-10) exposes false teaching.
- The purpose of the law (v. 3)
 - True circumcision = heart change
 - When we remove the heart from the ritual we're simply going through the motions.
- Reasons for confidence in the flesh – Paul's resume (v. 4-6)
- Worldly accounting vs. Kingdom accounting
 - The columns are switched (v. 7-8)
 - Our decisions are based on what we value more.
- Why kingdom accounting matters
 - Justification – From God, through faith in Christ (v. 9)
 - Sanctification – Ongoing process of cooperation with the Holy Spirit (v. 10)
 - Glorification – The final step (v. 11)
