BIG IDEA: GOD HELPS ME BE BRAVE

STEP THREE: CHOOSE AN ACTIVITY

FOR ALL KIDS: Safe from Harm

Materials: Egg, empty plastic water bottle, bowl

God protected Daniel in a big way! He kept Daniel from getting harmed by the hungry lions. God will protect us, too, when we are in scary situations. He can help us be brave!

Let's do a fun activity to help us remember that God sent his angel to protect Daniel.

Crack the egg into the bowl. Make sure the yolk does not break. If it does, you will need to get a new egg.

The bowl represents the cave. The yolk of the egg represents Daniel. The egg white represents the lions. The empty water bottle represents the angel sent to protect Daniel.

Squeeze the empty water bottle and place the mouth of the bottle next to the egg yolk. When you stop squeezing, the egg yolk will be sucked up into the bottle! Squeeze the bottle again to put the yolk back into the bowl!

You can do it again or let others try, as long as the yolk stays whole.

FOR YOUNGER KIDS: We're Going on a Lion Hunt

Materials: None

Instead of going on a bear hunt with your kids, go on a lion hunt! Act out this fun version with your family!

In the chorus, the words in parentheses indicate the kids will repeat what the grown-up says.
